

## **Largest Tillage Demo Ever Hits The Field**

**2010 field demo reaches new level with 13 companies and 24 pieces of equipment.**

Call it lucky 13 but one of the largest demos ever is heading for Canada's Outdoor Farm Show in 2010 as a herd of tillage manufacturers showcase their 24 pieces of tillage equipment.

The southwest demo field will be packed with steel for the tillage demo running 24 pieces daily for inspection. Manufacturers from across the globe will demonstrate their strip, primary and secondary tillage equipment in a daily field demo at Canada's Outdoor Farm Show – a chance for farmers to see and compare with their own eyes.

"Attendees love seeing the soil being broken up during demos," says Paul Roper, Demo Consultant for Canada's Outdoor Farm Show. "Tillage is always a great demonstration visually."

The daily demo will see 24 pieces of equipment run down the southwest demo field everyday starting at 12:30 p.m. Attendees will see Kverneland, John Deere, Landoll, Sunflower, SmartTill (Harco), Case IH, Great Plains, Amazone, DFK, Aerway, Penta, Salford and Vaderstad. Companies were invited to bring more than one piece of machinery which most companies are doing.

"There was an outstanding response from exhibitors when we announced a tillage demo for 2010," says Roper. "Soil health and creating the best seedbed are important issues in today's agriculture and consequently make a very topical demo."

Lined up side-by-side, each piece will be introduced by explaining its unique features and benefits. Attendees will see all equipment run down the field of oat stubble, showcasing those features and benefits in action.

Equipment on display will come in all different sizes and scales – from 13 feet to 20 feet. Roper encouraged companies to bring something new and feature advancements. "It has been about 5 years since the last major tillage demo," says Roper, "and exhibitors are ready to show off what's new."
