



## **Ag Energy Returns as Presenting Sponsor of Canadian Energy Expo**

A key part of Canada's Outdoor Farm Show is the Canadian Energy Expo (CEE) where green energy options are featured and demonstrated around the Ducks Unlimited Wetland Farm Pond. And a key part of CEE is the Ag Energy Co-operative – the Expo's presenting sponsor.

Based in Guelph, Ag Energy is an independent, member-owned co-operative formed in 1988 to provide energy products and services to its members, primarily but not exclusively, in the agriculture sector. With the implementation of the Green Energy Act in 2009, AgEnergy has offered producers in Ontario solar options for the Fit and Micro-Fit programs. As a result of this expansion, it seemed like a natural fit for the Canadian Energy Expo presented by Ag Energy Co-operative to return again this year showcasing numerous renewable green energy alternatives for farmers.

CEE became a formal part of COFS in 2009 and is a hub for companies interested in bringing green sustainable energy solutions to the farm. Exhibitor presentations range from solar, geothermal, wind, biogas, biomass and biofuels. Attendees can see these new technologies in live interactive settings, including approximately 4-acres of miscanthus and switchgrass demonstration plots, as well as a life-sized anaerobic digester, small-scale hydro-electric technology and solar trackers.
