With so many things to experience first-hand at Canada's Outdoor Farm Show, our theme 'Bringing Experiences to Life in the Field' celebrates the way we can all gather once a year and get close to new equipment, products and crops out in the field.

Many may have seen my announced retirement last fall, but, to be honest, there is no place I would rather be in September. Canada's Outdoor Farm Show team has asked me back again this year to help with the show. My passion for everything around farm shows is hard to deny, so you will be seeing me at the show again this year.

Here are a few highlights of things you will want to see at the show this year. Perhaps the best reason to attend is to celebrate agriculture and get together face-to-face with neighbours, friends and the many suppliers and companies at Eastern Canada's largest outdoor farm show.

Discovery Farm Woodstock

We continue to grow our offering of demonstration research projects and partners, and you will be able to see some of this work in the field through a guided "Off the Beaten Path Demonstration Research Tour" at the show this year. On August 2, Olds College of Agriculture & Technology announced that Discovery Farm Woodstock has joined the national Pan-Canadian Smart Farm Network. We are one of eight smart farms across four provinces working collaboratively towards advancing AgTech solutions and sustainability across Canada.

Dairy Innovation Centre

The Dairy Innovation Centre at Canada's Outdoor Farm Show offers a look into the latest in dairy technology and products that focus on animal comfort and productivity. Producers looking for ways to make their operations more efficient and create a better experience for their animals won't want to

miss visiting this collection of innovative companies offering products and leading-edge technology for dairy producers.

Field Demonstrations

With increased interest in cover crops in recent years, our Field Demonstrations will feature a Tillage of Cover Crops Demonstration and a Fertilizer Application Demonstration. We will also have a Forage Demonstration with mower conditioners and mergers, plus a Straw Chopper Demonstration for managing straw on the farm. And, watch for several Drone Demonstrations for a close up look at this evolving technology.

2023 Innovations Program

Canada's Outdoor Farm Show Innovations
Program, presented by Ontario Ministry of
Agriculture, Food and Rural Affairs (OMAFRA),
is back again this year. This program is a
reflection of the exciting growth that continues
in agricultural innovation with companies
applying for recognition in five categories:
agronomics, business solutions,
environmental sustainability, equipment and
livestock. Winners announced the night before
the show are featured throughout the show
with special onsite signage. Farmers are
invited to select one overall winner from all
five categories through the 2023 Farmers'
Choice Award.

The OMAFRA Innovation Pavilion is another place where you'll find new technology and initiatives highlighted by several startup companies that have great new ideas for the advancement of agriculture. Watch for special satellite locations by OMAFRA featured throughout the show that share the innovations driving productivity in the agriculture and food sector.

Evolution of Farming Demonstration: Autonomous Equipment in Action

Haggerty AgRobotics Company, Ltd., a leader in the emerging agriculture robotics and automation industry, will be continuing the discussion on the evolution of farming through the use of autonomous equipment. Their staff will be on-hand offering live demonstrations that feature several types of autonomous equipment at the show.

Agri-Business Park

The Agri-Business Park is where we all get to meet returning and new exhibitors who join the show to present products and services that make daily tasks on the farm a little easier. With over 100 acres of booths and displays, this is one of the places onsite that keeps our visitors coming back each year to experience what's new in agriculture.





Forage Demonstration

The value of a good crop of hay, and the uncertainty of Ontario's weather, means getting forage cut quickly is a key strategy when it comes time to harvest. This year, Canada's Outdoor Farm Show will showcase demonstrations of mower conditioners on Sept. 12 and 13 from companies such as Kubota Canada, and mergers on Sept. 14 from companies such as Delta Power, to assist with a quick and effective hay harvest.

Straw Chopper Demonstration

Straw Choppers are becoming more popular in livestock operations to aid in the management of cattle and sheep. Cutting the straw into small particles allows for better water absorption and retention, reducing the amount of product needed and saving money. Watch out for this demonstration in a new location this year (the Southwest demo field) to review features including material delivery options, ease of servicing, safety and machine versatility.

Drone Demonstration

The use of drone technology has become increasingly more common in the agriculture industry. Drones can be used on the farm in a number of ways: precision application, gathering valuable information for data-driven insights, aerial imagery, assessing crop health, scout fields, monitoring livestock and more. Regardless of their goals, operators manage woodlots with an eye to the future for generations to come.

In a farming operation, woodlots coexist and interact with the agricultural landscape, providing many benefits to farmers. Many advantages can be noted, such as soil and water conservation, biodiversity support, microclimate regulation and woodlots can serve as a habitat for wildlife. Additionally, woodlots provide opportunities for sustainable timber and non-timber forest product harvesting.

The woodlot demonstration at Canada's Outdoor Farm Show features a wide array of equipment, from firewood processors to chainsaws and wood splitters to inspire

Soil health & conservation award goes to Andrew Graham



ndrew Graham, Executive Director of Ontario Soil and Crop Improvement Association (OSCIA), has devoted many years working alongside government and industry partners on soil health including the development and delivery of stewardship education projects, innovative incentive programming, and applied research initiatives.

In 2023, the Soil Conservation Council of Canada announced Graham as the winner of the L.B. Thomson Award. The award recognizes individuals or organizations that have made a significant regional contribution to soil health and conservation.

The L.B. Thomson Award. administered by the Soil Conservation Council of Canada (SCCC), will be presented to Andrew Graham at Canada's Outdoor Farm Show on Wednesday, September 13 at 10:00 a.m. at the OSCIA Booth #S-610.

The L.B. Thomson Award was established in 1987 and is named in honour of Leonard Baden Thomson. Thomson was one of a group of agrologists who played a key role in developing soil conservation practices that minimized the effects of severe wind erosion that plagued the Prairies in the 1930s.


